Drawing on research from South Asia and sub-Saharan Africa, the session highlights consistent pathways linking climate stress to child labour, early marriage, unsafe migration, and multiple forms of violence against children. Participants will explore cross-sectoral strategies to strengthen child protection systems before, during, and after climate shocks.

- Identification of potential pathways for protecting children in climate disasters
