2 ADAPT SERVICES TO MEET THE VARIED NEEDS OF CHILDREN

3 STRENGTHEN COMMUNICATION, CHILD PARTICIPATION AND ACCOUNTABILITY

4 PRIORITISE SAFETY & WELLBEING AND AVOID CAUSING HARM

5 INCREASE NON-CHILD PROTECTION ACTORS' CAPACITY ON CHILD PROTECTION INCLUDING SAFE IDENTIFICATION, REFERRAL AND RESPONSE
